

Instrument of Government for Ysgol San Siôr Church in Wales Voluntary Aided School.

1. School.

The name of the school is Ysgol San Siôr Church in Wales Voluntary Aided School.

2. Category of School.

The school is a Voluntary Aided School.

3. Name of Governing Body.

The name of the Governing Body is Ysgol San Siôr Church in Wales Voluntary Aided School Governing Body.

4. Composition of Governing Body.

The Governing Body shall consist of:

- a) One Parent Governor;
- b) One LEA Governor;
- c) One Teacher Governor;
- d) One Staff Governor;
- e) Eight Foundation Governors (*to be appointed by Bangor Diocesan Trust – two of whom must be parents of pupils at school*);

Note:

- i) the incumbent of the Parish of Llandudno shall be a foundation governor '*ex-officio*'.
 - ii) the Bangor Diocesan Trust acting upon the recommendation of the incumbent and PCC of Llandudno Parish shall appoint a Foundation Governor to act in the place of the '*ex-officio*' Foundation Governor whose governorship derives from the office named in (i) above, in the event that the '*ex-officio*' Foundation Governor is unable or unwilling to act as Foundation Governor, or there is a vacancy in the office by virtue of which his governorship exists.
- f) the Head Teacher (except at the time when he/she has given written notice to the Clerk to the Governing Body of the school that he/she chooses not to be a Governor).
 - g) One Community Governor (one being a representative of the Community/Town Council).

5. Total Number.

The total membership of the Governing Body shall be fourteen (except any time when the Head Teacher has given notice that he/she chooses not to be a Governor in accordance with regulation 26(1), when the total number of Governors will be fourteen to maintain the regulated balance of Foundation Governors to other categories as stipulated in regulation 19(1))

6. Ethos Statement.

Recognising its historic foundation and in accordance with its Trust Deed, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church in Wales and in partnership with the Church at Parish and Diocesan level.

The school aims to serve its community by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significances of faith, and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers to all its pupils.

7. Date of Implementation.

Subject to regulation 37 of the Government of Maintained Schools (Wales) Regulations 2005, this Instrument of Government comes into effect:

- (i) on the date of making for the purpose of reconstituting the Governing Body;
- (ii) on the 9th May 2009.

8. Date of Order.

This Instrument was made by order of Conwy County Borough Council on 10th July 2009.
